Please note that vital information for the entire year is included in this handbook. Additionally, you will receive informational emails regarding upcoming activities; however, this handbook should be your reference for most information. Please take time to highlight important dates and read over our studio rules and expectations! Remember to check your email throughout the year for reminders and changes. We have also added our Bold Dance By Peach App as a resource. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us! We greatly appreciate your support and business!

POLICIES AND OTHER INFORMATION TUITION

All monthly fees are due by the FIRST of the month. There is a grace period of 10 days. Fees paid after the 10th are subject to a \$10 late fee. Regardless of the number of classes given in a month, tuition will remain consistent. No deductions are given for missed lessons and there are no refunds. Many of the classes are duplicated and can be made up at an alternate time. Our studio will only accept credit/debit cards for payments at this time. If your account is delinquent by 3 months, your dancer will be asked to observe and cannot participate until the balance is paid. You can manage your family's account and check your balance on the Jackrabbit Parent Portal. The link to this page is provided on our studio website. Please feel free to come to us with any questions you may have!

CLASS HELPERS

Many of our students want to assist our dance staff in the care and instruction of our younger dancers and we love this! These dedicated dancers perform many tasks to ensure that instructors can devote their time to direct instruction and help classes run smoothly. Helper duties include bathroom assistance, getting tissues, assisting with mats and props, lining up children, helping with shoes, and providing encouragement. If you are interested in being a class helper, please contact Peach or our front desk staff with your available dates and times, and to get the information for our Assistants Program Course and information!

WEATHER CANCELLATIONS

In the event of inclement weather, we will post on our social media sites, will send notifications on our app and will email the classes for the night regarding any cancellations. Most classes are duplicates and can be made up at an alternate time. **Make up classes are required to be made up one week after canceled class.** Please contact us with any questions regarding a make-up time and class.

MAKE UP POLICY

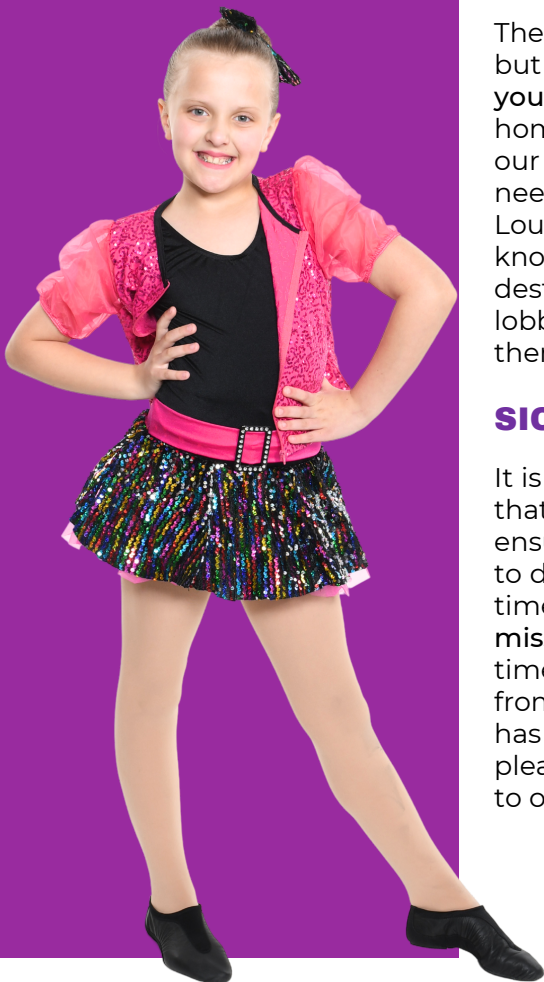
If class is canceled or your dancer misses, you can attend a make-up class. You may choose any class of the same level to attend. Please reach out to Peach or staff if you have questions about what class would be appropriate to attend. **Make up classes are required to be made up one week after canceled/missed class.**

WAITING ROOM/CLASS VIEWING

The dance rooms are closed to observers so that your dancer can focus, but **you are able to watch the recorded classes by going to the link in your Parent Portal!** We record every class so your dancer can practice at home or catch up if they miss a practice. Parents are welcome to wait in our lobby while your little ones are attending classes. If other children need to accompany you, please keep them quiet and closely supervised. Loud lobbies can be distracting to your dancers in the next room! We know that accidents happen, but you may be held accountable for any destruction of studio property that takes place. Please keep the lobby/restrooms clean. Dancers and families are to pick up after themselves and help us to keep our studio a place we can be proud of!

SICKNESS/INJURY POLICY

It is our policy that if your child was home sick or has any symptoms, that that they do not come to the studio or participate in class. We want to ensure that they are no longer contagious and are physically well enough to dance. Most classes are duplicates and can be made up at an alternate time. **Make up classes are required to be made up one week after missed class.** Please contact us with any questions regarding a make-up time and class! You can also watch the recorded class that you missed from your home with the link provided in your Parent Portal. If your child has an injury requiring them to observe, rather than participate in class, please inform us right away! Our staff will not administer any medication to our students.



CLASS ENVIRONMENT

Parents and, guardians, and students can expect that all staff will respect the well-being of each student, treat each student fairly, and encourage each student's growth and self-esteem as unique individuals. Should any concern or issue arise, please contact the Bold Dance by Peach Staff at Bolddancers@gmail.com.

- Dancers are to arrive on time and prepared for class. This includes wearing proper attire (outlined in our Dress Code Document) and having hair pulled back and off the face.
- No food or drink (other than water) is permitted in the studio.
- Gum is prohibited during class.
- In class and rehearsals, dancers must be fully engaged in executing the material being taught or reviewed.
- Talking, sitting, cell phones and bad attitudes or other behavior disruptive to the class is prohibited.
- Just as teachers are expected to respect students, students are expected to respect each other, the teachers, and the studio.
- Dancers who consistently refuse to follow directions or respect their teachers/classmates may be asked to sit out of class, as outlined in the Behavior Policy below.
- Violent behavior will not be tolerated.

In class and rehearsals, dancers must be fully engaged in executing the material being taught or reviewed. Talking, sitting, cell phones and bad attitudes or other behavior disruptive to the class is prohibited. If behaviors are an issue a dancer will be asked to leave in lieu of any other warning.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

We are committed to educate the students, model behaviors, and help dancers grow with love and respect in this program. If for any reason a student does not meet the expectations outlined above, Bold Dance By Peach enforces a 3-strike policy with regard to such student's behavior. If a student is unable to follow the expectations, they may be asked to leave Bold Dance with no refund. Each case will be handled individually with the teacher/parents/child/staff.

- Strike 1 is a warning: the student will still be able to participate in dance class
- Strike 2 is an in-class time-out: the student will be asked to sit out and observe. The instructor will determine the length of time for the time-out.
- Strike 3 is an early dismissal from class: the student's parents will be called to pick them up from class.

RECITAL PERFORMANCE 2027

At the conclusion of our 2026/2027 season, we will hold our annual recital at Ames City Auditorium on June 5th and 6th Dress Rehearsal will be June 3rd and 4th.

Dancers are not required to participate but are encouraged to as it is an experience unlike any other! Notes regarding the recital will be emailed throughout the year.

IF THERE IS A BALANCE ON YOUR ACCOUNT, YOUR DANCER WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE RECITAL PERFORMANCE.



RECITAL PERFORMANCE/COSTUME FEES

All students are invited to perform at our recital, though are not required to do so. If for any reason you wish for your student to not participate, please indicate this by the time the Recital Fee is due. Recital and Costume Fees commit you to following all recital policies and tells us that you're expecting your child to be performing in our annual Spring Recital. Also, if you would like to be a parent volunteer backstage at recital, a sign-up sheet will be available towards the end of the season. Our show cannot happen without the help of our loving dance families! Thank you for volunteering!

RECITAL PERFORMANCE FEE PER FAMILY

Paid by October 31st - \$90 + tax

Paid after October 31st - \$95 + tax

The Recital Performance Fee is to help with the cost of our show, facility rental, lights, programs, music licensing, and scenery. This fee also informs us that your dancer plans to participate in our show. The Recital Performance Fee is due by October 31st. There are no refunds for this fee.

COSTUME FEE

Preschool Combo Classes and any other additional class your child takes that will be performing one dance in the show.- \$20 + tax.

Kindergarten-1st Grade Combo Classes- \$40 + tax.

2nd-12th Grade Combo Classes - \$60 + tax.

This fee is required for EACH student participating in the recital and is due for each individual class. This fee is due December 31st and will be deducted from your final costume bill in February!

Costumes for the recital must be ordered 6+ months prior to the recital date, so it is important that we know if your child will be performing ahead of time as measuring of students will happen by our seamstress shortly into the year. The purchase prices of costumes range from \$50-\$90 a costume (depending on the age and size of the child and inflation). Costume companies require ready-made costumes to be pre-paid, so the costume deposit policy is strictly enforced. These costumes will be yours to keep after the performance!

All alterations done by our studio seamstress will have a \$35 charge per costume. Our in-house seamstress is available for limited alterations throughout the season. Our in-house seamstress has limited availability and all alteration requests must be submitted through the front desk for review. We'll do our best to accommodate, but families are always welcome to use their own seamstress if preferred.

Costumes are not distributed in the spring if you have an account balance at that time. There are no refunds.

DROPPING OF CLASS

Students needing to drop a class will need to do so in writing by the 15th of the prior month to avoid payments for the upcoming month. Please send these requests to BoldDanceFrontDesk@gmail.com. Accounts will be considered active until written notice is given to the studio. Please keep in mind that your child's commitment to a class affects everyone involved with that class! Choreography is made to suit the direct number of students involved in a class, so dropping late in the season will cause not only choreography changes, but the entire routine to be reworked for all instructors and students involved.

If you decide to drop a class after January 1st, there will be a \$35 Late Season Drop Processing Fee.



ATTENDANCE FEE

Regular attendance is important to your dancer's progress and to the success of each class and performance. Consistent participation helps dancers build technique, confidence, and retain choreography throughout the season.

Dancers who miss more than five (5) classes during the dance season may have portions of their recital choreography adjusted. At the instructor's discretion, a dancer may be choreographed to enter or exit the stage at different times, be moved to alternate formations, or be removed from sections of the routine if excessive absences impact their ability to safely and successfully perform the choreography.

We understand that illnesses, family obligations, and unexpected situations arise. If your dancer will be absent, please notify the studio as soon as possible. Whenever possible, dancers are encouraged to attend a makeup class to help stay current with class material and choreography.

MONTHLY TUTION

Auto withdrawn the 1st of every month- Dependent on classes registered for

LATE FEE

A \$10 Late Fee will be added to all accounts after the 10th of month for over due payments.

RECITAL FEE

Paid by October 31st - \$90 + tax

Paid after October 31st - \$95 + tax

COSTUME DEPOSIT

\$20 + tax per COSTUME (total dependent on classes registered for)

FINAL COSTUME BILL

Due March 22nd - Total cost of costume - deposit previously paid (dependent on what classes registered for)

RECITAL ATTENDANCE FEE

Due in May- this is a \$35 + tax fee per family that allows open/unlimited invitations to our shows

FINALE/RECITAL T-SHIRT FEE

Amount TBD- This is a fee for all participants in Show 2 and Show 3 Finale, Boys Dance and Parent/Daddy and Me Dances that will perform in our shows.
